## **Stop Press!!! New T20 Blast Competition Approved by MJCA and Ready to Roll at Melton Centrals CC!**

- The MJCA has been approached by Cricket Australia to run a new pilot program, the "T20 Blast".
- The program is designed to be a stepping stone into cricket matches from in2cricket, before players go to Under 12s.
- This program sees 8 weeks of games for players aged between 8 and 10 years old. Games are shortened versions of the game of cricket, with modified rules in place. The season runs from November-December and February (four weeks in each block). All games are Monday nights, at Kurunjang Recreation Reserve.
- Cost is \$60, which gets players the T20 Blast Uniform of Vest and Cap as well as buying centre equipment. This cost is in addition to the \$70 for in2cricket (being that these programs are done at cost – the cost being for the gear kids get).
- As a club, we will be looking to enter two teams of players who are playing in our in2cricket program. The aim being, players are learning skills at in2cricket, playing in the T20 Blast as well and then moving into Under 12s next year.

## **Senior Pre-Season Training**

- Our Senior's have settled into pre-season training, with training running on a weekly basis as follows:
  - Saturdays, 10am to 11.30am @ Clubrooms.
  - Tuesdays, 6pm to 7.30pm @ Melton Indoor Sports Centre > cost of \$5 per player per session.

## **Junior Pre-Season Training**

- Our Juniors have hit the ground running, with the following training details for their sessions:
  - **Under 12s:** Monday & Wednesday, 5pm to 6pm @ Clubrooms (we will train from 5.30pm to 7.00pm when daylight allows – you will hear from the coaches in this area when the changeover happens).
  - **Under 14s & 16s:** Tuesday & Thursday, 4.30pm-6pm @ Clubrooms (we will commence training in this timeslot and train in this timeslot throughout the pre-season).

## **In2Cricket**

- Our In2Cricket program is back again this year, and we plan to build on our success last year. At the moment, the club is calling around all players to ensure they are joining the program again this season.
- We start our season on Friday October 21, running from 4.30pm to 5.45pm on Fridays – the same as last season.
- *Cost this season is \$70 per participant, to again cover the giveaway pack and the club cap.*
